Can I bring my children to the Buddhist Centre?

Safeguarding laws mean that we need to limit the circumstances in which we can welcome children to the Buddhist Centre.

<u>Under 16s</u>

Children Under 16 can come to the Buddhist Centre's daytime festivals. They need to be supervised at all times by a responsible adult.

On other occasions, children under 16 cannot attend our classes and courses.

When can children aged 16 and 17 come to the Buddhist Centre?
